Located on adjoining K-8 and high school campuses in the Tremont neighborhood, NEO College Preparatory has graduated 100% of seniors since opening its doors in 2010. NEO College Preparatory is on a positive academic trajectory, significantly improving its Overall Value-Added rating year-over-year to A from D. The school offers extracurricular, athletic, and specialty academic programs such as College Credit Plus where students have the opportunity to earn college in addition to high school credit.

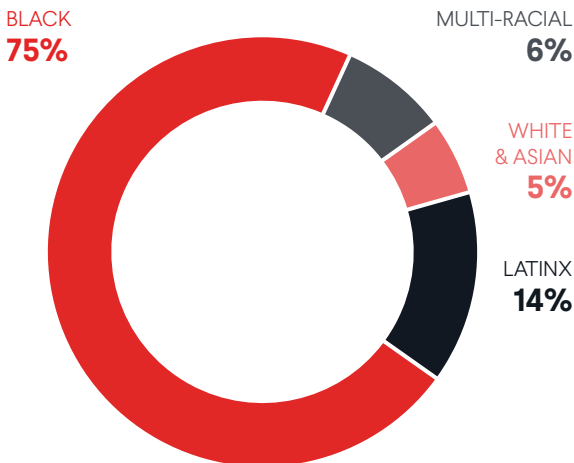
